April 22 was Earth Day. As I reported last year, Gaylord Nelson was the politician that spearheaded Earth Day here in the U.S. It is said that one of his motivations for the movement was his viewing of the oil spill off the coast of Santa Barbara in January 1969. There was a general concern by many Americans about the state of the environment during that time, but, as individuals, those concerned did not know what to do. As Senator Nelson was contemplating Earth Day, the Cuyahoga River in Ohio caught fire. About two months after the fire, in August of 1969, Time Magazine ran an article about it with pictures that caught the attention of our nation.

However, the pictures were from a previous fire in 1952 that had burned for three days. The 1969 fire lasted only 30 minutes. Using the publicity from the oil spill and the river fire, Senator Nelson announced the grassroots movement called Earth Day to be April 22, 1970. He called for a teach-in at the nation's colleges and universities where environmental concerns would be discussed. The reaction was much greater than the senator expected. After a short while, he had to ask for college volunteers to help organize the events. He chose Denis Hayes, student body president of Stanford, to organize the events. That first Earth Day "brought 20 million Americans out into the spring sunshine for peaceful demonstrations in favor of environmental reform." Later that year, the EPA was founded. Many important pieces of environmental legislation were passed that year, among them: Clean Air Act, the Water Quality Improvement Act, the Endangered Species Act, the Toxic Substances Control Act and the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act. Now Earth Day is celebrated in 175 countries. Many environmental laws have been passed in the United States since that first Earth Day. The rivers of our nation and the air in many of its cities are much cleaner now than they were in 1970. Our pictures are, from the top left in clockwise order, Senator Nelson Gaylord, Denis Hayes, and the Cuyahoga River fire of 1952.
