February was "Black History Month".

One of the great black men in U.S. history was George Washington Carver. He was born to a slave girl named Mary on the Farm belonging to Moses Carver in 1864 in Missouri. Shortly after he was born, he and his mother were kidnapped (it was during the Civil War). Moses Carver brought George back, but could not find his mother. Moses and his wife (both German immigrants to the US), raised George and his brother James as their own. At 12 years of age George went away to live and work on a farm so he could go to a black school to get his education. At the age of 26, George gained entrance to Simpson College as its first black student. He transferred the next year to Iowa Agricultural College. He graduated and became the first black staff member. In 1897, Booker T. Washington, founder of Tuskegee Normal and Industrial Institute for Negroes, convinced George to become the school's Director of Agriculture. He served there until he died in 1943. George Washington Carver made many inventions using agriculture and developed his crop rotation method to aid the largely agricultural based south, which had suffered much during and after the Civil War. He freely gave his agricultural inventions to all people, not getting patents. "God gave them to me" he would say about his ideas, "How can I sell them to someone else?" He only got three patents in his life, and they had to do with making paints and stains from soybeans. While George Washington Carver is most widely recognized for his scientific contributions regarding the peanut, he is also often recognized as a devoted Christian. "He could have added fortune to fame, but caring for neither, he found happiness and honor in being helpful to the world." - Epitaph on the grave of George Washington Carver.
