The Choys and Susan and Charles are back from their cruise! Susan's husband, Charles, sent me some photos and they will be up in our Gallery on our site. From the photos I can see that they were at the Biltmore Hotel in Coral Gables, Florida. Also, I see that their cruise ship went by Miami. Aside from that, I really don't know or remember where they went. Starting at the top



left picture and going clockwise, we have a picture of Susan and Charles in front of the Biltmore Hotel, then a skyline of Miami from the cruise ship, then the Choys with their granddaughter and finally the view of the cruise ship from the top deck. I don't know if they toured it, but the Biltmore Hotel is a National Historic Landmark. It was built in 1926 as part of the Biltmore Hotel chain and, at the time it was built, was the tallest building in Miami. When it was most popular, royalty from Europe and Hollywood often stayed there. The Duke and Duchess of Windsor, Judy Garland, Bing Crosby, Al Capone, and assorted Roosevelts and Vanderbilts were among those that stayed at the Biltmore. Franklin D. Roosevelt had a temporary White House office set up there for when he vacationed on his fishing trips from Miami. There were gala balls, aquatic shows and weddings. The hotel made it through the nation's economic declines in the late 20's and early 30's by hosting aquatic galas that drew great crowds. People would come to watch the shows. Johnny Weissmuller, the Olympic swimmer (and later star of twelve Tarzan movies) gave performances and lessons in the swimming pool, which, at the time, was the largest swimming pool in the world. On one occasion he broke a world record in the pool.
