I heard that the New Year's celebration last week was a great success. The food and fellowship were good and the performances were great. Unfortunately, I was unable to attend as I was helping my daughter and son-in-law take care of my granddaughter, who had a cold and sore throat. They all were staying at my house temporarily just before moving to Anchorage, Alaska, where my son-in-law has a new, better, job. The first picture is the



last one I have of Charlotte in her old home. The next three pictures were taken at LAX early in the morning of Feb. 23rd. They had a 6:20 am flight to Anchorage. Now I have a reason to visit Alaska. Why does February only have 28 days? Our calendar is from the ancient Romans. They only had 10 months in their calendar and it went from March to December with 304 days. That explains why December starts with dec, which means ten. The 61 days of winter were ignored as they were unimportant to farmers. Then the early roman ruler, Numa Pompilius, added January and February to the end to "complete" the calendar. Now it had 355 days to correspond to a 12 month lunar calendar. The other 10.25 days of the Solar calendar were added in by the religious leaders as an extra month every so often. Even numbers were considered unlucky but a 355 day, 12 month calendar requires one month with an even number of days. Since February was at the end of the calendar, it was assigned 28 days. The priests did not do a good job of putting in the extra month so the Roman ruler Julius Caesar made the calendar essentially as we know it today, with a 365.25 day solar year. At some point January was changed to the first month. The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid? Psalms 27:1
