

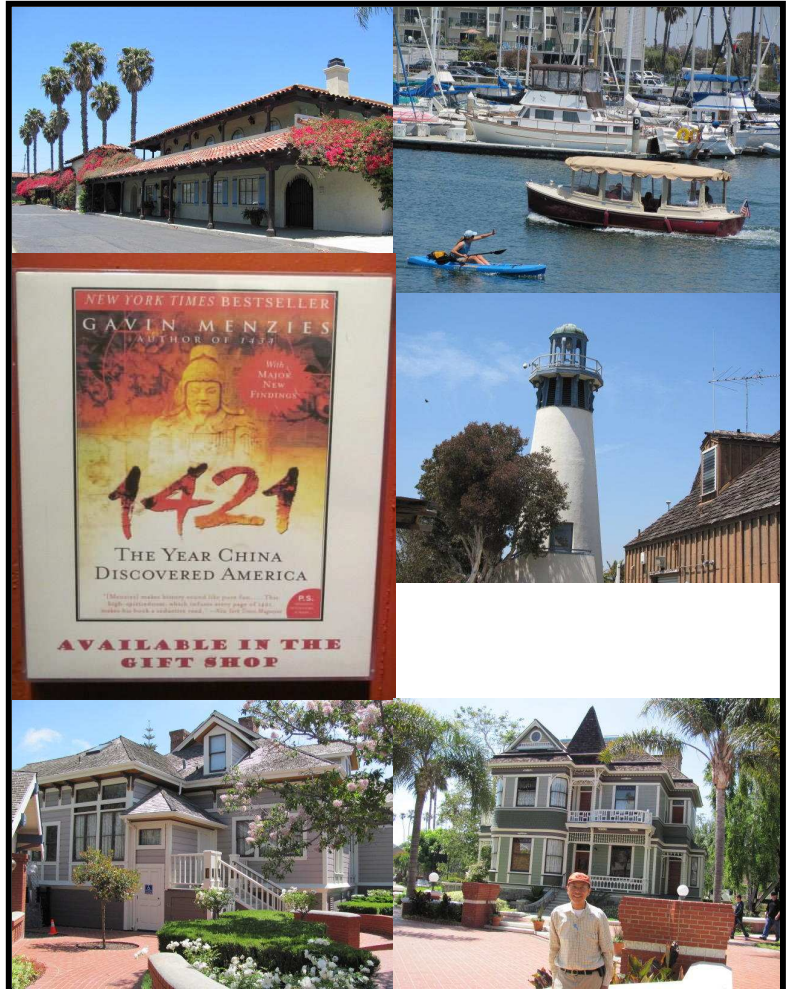

The first Father's Day celebration in the United States was held in Spokane, Washington on June 19, 1910, 100 years ago today. Mrs. Sonora Smart Dodd had the idea after she heard about Mother's Day. Her father, Mr. William Jackson Smart, a civil war veteran, had raised his children by himself after the early death of his wife. Although many people believed it would be a good thing to honor fathers, it was 62 years later, in 1972, before Father's Day became a national holiday. One advocate for making Father's Day a national holiday, Senator Margaret Chase Smith, said, in 1957, "Either we honor both our parents, mother and father, or let us desist from honoring either one. But to single out just one of our two parents and omit the other is the most grievous insult imaginable."
