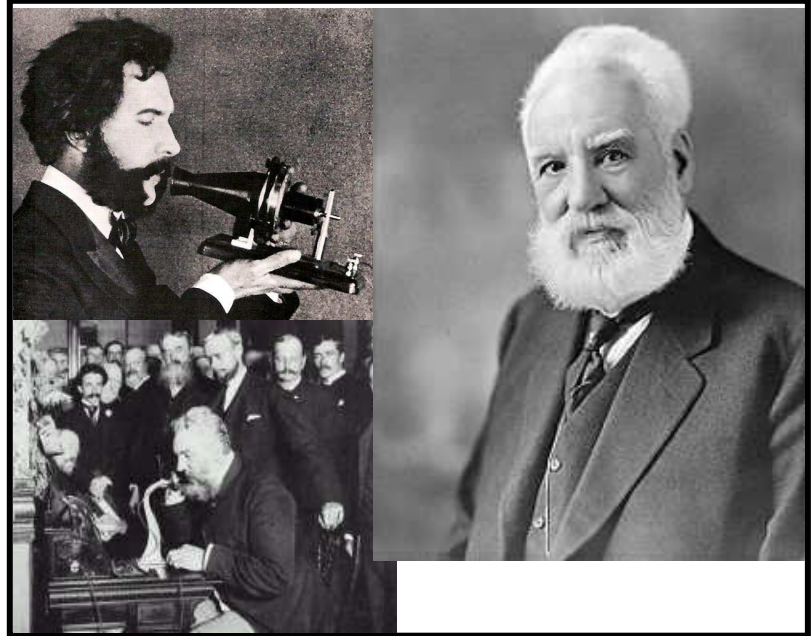

Today is the 133rd anniversary of the first patent of the telephone. On March 7, 1876, Alexander Graham Bell was granted the U.S. patent for the invention of the telephone. Dr. Bell was born and raised in Scotland. He went to school in England and his family moved to Canada when he was 23 years old. He came from a family who were very interested in



helping the deaf. His grandfather and Father were both instrumental in helping the deaf to communicate and to read lips. His interest became personal when his mother started to go deaf when he was 12 years old. Throughout his life he was very interested in acoustics or the science of sound. He was also an inventor and even invented a device for taking the husks off of grains when he was only 12 years old. He was hired by several Institutes for the deaf in the U.S. to teach his methods to their teachers and he had his own private pupils, one of which he eventually married. At the same time he was working on a way to send sound over a telegraph wire. He was aided by his assistant, Thomas A. Watson, an experience electrical designer and mechanic. The first transmission was of Dr. Bell calling for Mr. Watson. After that he made many demonstrations to many people. The Bell Telephone Company was created in 1877, and by 1886, over 150,000 people in the U.S. owned telephones. Bell company engineers made numerous other improvements to the telephone, which emerged as one of the most successful products ever. In 1879, the Bell Company acquired Edison's patents for the carbon microphone from Western Union. This made the telephone practical for long distances and it was no longer necessary to shout to be heard at the receiving telephone. And the world has changed because of the telephone. When I was a child the most common way to communicate with someone at a great distance (in another city, state, or country) was by writing a letter. Today, it is rare to receive a letter of any length.
