**Remember the Alamo!** Have you ever heard this phrase? Do you know what it means? First, let me tell you a little history. In 1835, General Santa Ana, who was also the president of Mexico, abolished the constitution of 1824, and proclaimed a new constitution in its place. In the new constitution Santa Ana was, effectively, the dictator of Mexico. Before this, the governments of the Mexican states



also had a say in government decisions. The majority of the settlers in the Mexican state that contained Texas were American immigrants who had liked the first Mexican constitution and were opposed to the new one. Therefore they started the Texas Revolution and tried to secede from Mexico. By 1836 they had driven the Mexican army from Texas. General Santa Ana brought an Army into the Texas region to retake the territory. The Battle of the Alamo started on February 23<sup>rd</sup> when General Santa Ana, with an army of 1500 soldiers, attacked the Alamo mission which had been turned into a fort and had about 200 Texian soldiers in it. On March 6, 1836, Santa Ana's army defeated the soldiers at the Alamo, killing all of them. It is believed that five to seven soldiers surrendered, but they were immediately executed. There were some non combatants, including slaves and women and children that were spared. They reported the details of the battle and many people were outraged at the treatment given to the Texian soldiers. Later, on April 21, 1836, in the battle that defeated General Santa Ana, many of the Texian soldiers were heard to shout, "Remember the Alamo!" This battle ended the war and the Republic of Texas was created. The Alamo is located in San Antonio Texas and is considered to be a historical site. The Texas legislature purchased the Alamo in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century and gave it to the Daughters of the Republic of Texas as permanent caretakers. If you visit San Antonio, be sure to visit the Alamo.
