Today is May 1st, commonly called May Day. When I was a child, we used to make little baskets full of flowers, leave them on the doorstep of someone, ring the bell, and run. They weren't supposed to see who left the flowers. We also used to, on occasion, have a Maypole dance at school. Some tall flagpole would have different colored ribbons attached to the top and people would get in a circle around the pole, each holding the other end of one of the ribbons. Then we would dance around the pole in opposite directions until the ribbons were wound tightly around the pole. It was a celebration of spring. The word Mayday is also used as a distress call. In 1923 Frederick Mockford, a senior radio operator at Croydon Airport in London, was asked to think of a word that would indicate distress and be easily recognized by all. He chose Mayday, because it sounds like a French phrase which means, “you come help me”. It has been used since then as a call of distress. The time it was used that most people are aware of is in the Titanic disaster. Mayday is repeated three times, followed by the ship's name three times, followed by Mayday and then the ship and its problem and location. It is a crime to use Mayday unnecessarily.
