Electronic Waste includes Microwave Ovens, CD-Players, Computers and Computer Monitors, Appliances, Cell Phones, Televisions, Stereos, Printers, DVD/DVR Players, VCR's

I looked online and found out that just plain old florescent bulbs, even the 2' or 4' or 8' ones are also considered hazardous waste. The unfortunate thing about this waste collection event is that it is at the same time as the Mother's Day event.
