It looks like our class had a good time at Bonelli Park last Saturday. You can see that they had good food and a wonderful day. If you weren't able to attend, you missed out. I know Ming and Maggie were on a cruise, so maybe they had a good time, too. I was unable to attend as I had been invited to a "100 Day" party for a friend's grandson. I had never heard of celebrating the 100th day



after birth. However, it is a custom that some Chinese families celebrate (I have heard that Koreans also have this celebration). Ethan Chen was really well behaved at his party and didn't even cry when confronted by the Chinese Lion! You can see that his mother thought it was funny, but Ethan just took it all in as something interesting that was happening. Monday is, once again, Memorial Day. Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day and was to honor the soldiers who died in the Civil War. It was first observed on May 30, 1868, when flowers were placed on the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers in Arlington National Cemetery. After World War I it was changed to honor all Americans who died fighting in any war. In 1915 Moina Michael conceived the idea to wear poppies in honor of our dead soldiers. She sold poppies to her friends and co-workers and used the money to benefit servicemen in need. In 1922 the VFW (Veterans of Foreign Wars) became the first veteran's organization to sell poppies nationally. In 1971, congress changed the day of observance from May 30th to the last Monday in May to make a three day weekend. Many think that this is one reason people tend not to truly honor our dead soldiers on the day. Since the 1950's, on the Thursday before Memorial Day, the 1,200 soldiers of the 3rd US Infantry place small American flags at each of the 260,000 gravestones in Arlington National Cemetery. They then patrol 24 hours a day to make sure the flags remain standing on Memorial Day.
