Mt. Rushmore. The lower right picture is of Henson with two church friends at Sedona, Arizona. He and his friends went to Sedona and the Grand Canyon. Mt. Rushmore, as you can see, is a manmade attraction. Historian Doane Robinson conceived the idea for Mount Rushmore in 1923 to promote tourism in South Dakota. His idea was to carve busts of presidents into the mountains to commemorate the first 150 years of the United States. In 1924 Robinson persuaded sculptor Gutzon Borglum to travel to the Black Hills region to ensure that the carvings could be done. Borglum rejected the first site proposed for the monument and chose Mount Rushmore instead. In 1925 Congress authorized the Mount Rushmore National Memorial Commission. Between Oct. 4, 1927 and Oct. 31, 1941, Gutzon Borglum and 400 workers sculpted the 60 foot carvings of U.S. presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln. These presidents were selected by Gutzon Borglum because of their role in preserving the republic and expanding its territory. Gutzon Borglum died in March 1941. His son, Lincoln Borglum continued the project. No workmen died as a result of accidents during the construction, although there were injuries. In 1991, President George H. Bush officially dedicated Mount Rushmore.
