Did you hear the good news? Henson has passed his citizenship test! Congratulations! Well, today's newsletter will be about something beautiful, at least to many people. It is about Orchids. There is a show you can go to in Santa Ana; the flyer is available on request. Orchids are plants that grow on every continent except Antarctica. The only commercially grown orchid is the vanilla, from which we get vanilla flavoring. Orchids grow on trees, rocks and rocky soil. All orchids grow in symbiosis with a fungus. In nature, an orchid seed will not germinate without being infected by the fungus, so, no fungus, no plants from seeds. This was not understood when Orchids were first grown. They became popular in the 19th century in England. Mr. William Cattley grew some plants that had been brought to him from South America (where many orchids grow). The orchids flowered in 1818 and immediately created a sensation. Not only were the flowers beautiful, but they lasted a very long time and smelled good. Many rich people in England started to import orchids from South America and to raise orchids. Unfortunately, they thought that the orchids should be raised in tropical conditions, so many of the transplants died. Eventually it was learned that orchids needed more light, more air, less heat and suitable stuff to grow on. But, there were few plants from seeds until it was understood, in the early 20th century, how orchid seeds work. Then people began the hybridization of orchids to get great new varieties. Today there are more than 100,000 orchid hybrids, and the list grows each year. The seeds of orchids do not necessarily produce orchids that are as pretty as their parent. Therefore, until about 1961, having a beautiful orchid was very expensive. However, in 1961 it was found how to grow an orchid from a tissue sample. It is, in effect, a clone of the parent. Since that time the cost of orchids has gone down and today, most anyone may own a beautiful orchid.
