pizza. Henson will be our guide. Halloween is almost upon us. One of the traditions of Halloween in America is to carve a pumpkin into a Jack-o-lantern. The carving of Jack-o-lanterns was first practiced in ancient Ireland. It was probably used as a way to scare off the spirits that were supposed to wander around on October 31st, looking for a body to occupy. The Irish Jack-o-lanterns were carved out of vegetables, usually turnips and a burning coal was used to light the Jack-o-lantern. Today Jack-o-lanterns are carved from pumpkins. However, there were no pumpkins in Europe until after the “discovery” of America. Pumpkins are native to the western hemisphere. When the Irish immigrated to America they brought the tradition with them. When they discovered how easy it was to carve a pumpkin (which was very inexpensive in America), they switched to carving pumpkins into Jack-o-lanterns. Halloween and Jack-o-lantern carving became popular in America after the Irish immigrated to America during the Irish Potato famine in the 1840's.
